TO: SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE RESIDENTS:

As you may know the following streets are deemed Snow Emergency Routes in the Borough of West Conshohocken:

**Josephine Avenue**  
**Bullock Avenue (BOTH SIDES)**  
**Dehaven Avenue**

**New Dehaven Street**  
**Spring Garden Street**

With the impending inclement weather, beginning Wednesday morning, December 16, 2020, 8:00 a.m. through Thursday evening, 8:00 p.m., if the current forecast doesn't change, snow emergency has been declared.

**We are advising that all vehicles MUST be parked and stay parked on the EVEN side of the following roadways until the snow emergency is over: Josephine Avenue, Dehaven Avenue, New Dehaven Street and Spring Garden Street. Bullock Avenue, no parking permitted during the snow emergency.**

Once Public Works has cleaned your street please be courteous and **DO NOT PUSH** snow back out onto the street as this will cause re-icing conditions. Please be advised that borough ordinance Chapter 99, Article I. Snow, Grass and Dirt Removal, section C, #3 states "It Shall be unlawful to throw, shovel or plow snow into or upon any roads and streets within the Borough with the intent of allowing such snow to remain on such roads and streets" and is subject to a fine up to \$1,000. You may also be asked to move your vehicle so that the Streets Department can maintain a clear roadway for Emergency vehicles.

Please watch the local news and our Facebook page for updates as the storm approaches. If your vehicle(s) are not moved you will incur the possibility of a fine as well as having your vehicle being towed.

The Borough wishes to make the snow removal process easy, uncomplicated and safe as possible and would very much appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation and especially your understanding as we try to make this process as painless as possible for all.
