OLD BUSINESS

Official Map: Mr. Curran indicated that the Consent Agenda had a copy of the comments to Council for the official map and sent to Council in October. Mr. Moreno indicated that Council would review any further comments at the November meeting before adoption. This discussion includes previous recommendations and any new recommendations. The only comments from this evening would be for more green space. Mr. Curran asked if there were any comments from the surrounding municipalities no comments have been submitted. The Montgomery County Planning Commission has also received the draft of the official map.

MacKenzie Park: Mr. Curran indicated that everyone has received the phase plan for MacKenzie Park. Mr. Davis suggested that communication should include Pat Zapien as director of Parks & Rec. Mr. Davis wanted to inquire about the work schedule to which Mr. Dymtryk indicated that there was a Pre-Bid meeting for questions. Bid opening will be on November 9th and the engineers' comments will go to Council. Phase 1 is expected to be completed by end of spring 2024. Phase II grants are being reviewed for application. Discussion took place regarding solicitation for funds.

NEW BUSINESS

James Donohue wanted to discuss opening of the paper roads within the Borough for resident parking. Ted Dymtryk indicated that this might not be beneficial for parking. Dave Frankenfield also spoke about the history of the paper roads. Discussions to bring to the attention of Council and revisit as a part of the vision plan. Discussion to have planner come to PC meeting to discuss future possibilities of the Community for parking

Guy Davis asked about updates for the Simone Collins
